BELMONT – Harland Lorne Bartlett, 73, of Tioga Drive, died Wednesday, Nov. 10, 2004, at home after a long illness.

He was born in Boscawen, March 9, 1931, the son of the late Arthur Bartlett, who died in 1981, and his mother, Iyla (Hanson) Bartlett, who died in 1983.

Harland lived in Boscawen during his youth and graduated from Penacook High School, class of 1949. Prior to moving to Belmont in 1965, he had lived in Franklin for 30 years.

He worked for more than 25 years with Riverside Mill Work "Rivco" in Penacook, retiring as a foreman. He served with the "Much Do Hose Company," Boscawen Fire Department as call man and clerk for 14 years and later call man, retired, Captain of Engine Co. 1, Franklin Fire Department, for 13 years.

He was a charter member and past president of the VFF (Veteran Fire Fighters). Harland was a member of the Belmont Boogie Busters snow machine club and was trailmaster for two years and member of the Groveton Trail Riders. He was a member of the Boscawen Congregational Church, UCC and Ezekiel Webster Grange.

He enjoyed woodworking, crafting, camping, cooking and time spent with family and friends. NASCAR was a weekly event he never missed.

He was predeceased by two brothers, Myron "Mike" Bartlett in 1966, Arthur Bartlett Jr. in 1996; a grandson, Lorne A. Joslyn in 1967; and a daughter, Mrs. Walter (Velma) Joslyn, June 27, 2004.
