

# Jennie Bujnievicz

BELMONT — Jennie Bujnievicz, 86, formerly of 19 Parker St., Laconia, and a resident of Belmont since January, died Wednesday, June 9, 1999 in Belmont.

She was born in East Boston, Mass., on June 15, 1912. She was the daughter of Boniface and Anna (Simatonis) Bujnievicz and had resided all of her life in Laconia.

~~Miss Bujnievicz was educated by the Sisters of Mercy at St. John School in Laconia and was a graduate of Laconia High School.~~

She was a member of the Laconia High School National Honor Society and the Debating Club. She attended the University of New Hampshire in Durham, where she was a member of Chi Omega Society, Phi Kappa, Phi Kappa Delta Pi, and other honor societies.

She received her master's degree from Middlebury College after attending summer school at the Bread Loaf School of English and continued her education at the University of Colorado, Boston University, Harvard and UNH.

Miss Bujnievicz began her teaching career in Laconia.

Her students at Laconia High School, from the 1930s and 1940s, remember her as a very caring and excellent teacher of English. For a number of years, she was advisor to The Lakonian, the student newspaper.

She later moved to Massachusetts, where she taught in Winchester, Watertown and Lexington schools. She retired in 1975 and returned to Laconia.

She was a communicant of St. Joseph R. C. Church, Laconia.
