Arnold S. Foote Jr., 77, of 132 Seavey Rd., Belmont, died early Thursday morning, January 25, 2007, at his home.

He was born October 13, 1929, in Laconia, the son of the late Arnold S. and Waver (Lampher) Foote Sr. He was a graduate of the Laconia School System and was a long time resident of Belmont.

Arnold was a World War II Army veteran, serving in Germany. He was awarded the Army of Occupation Medal and the Good Conduct Medal.

Prior to his retirement in 1984, he was a civil servant for the Department of the Army.

Arnold had a love for genealogy, and was the Historian for the Amadon Family Genealogy Society.

Survivors include his wife of 54 years, Edith (Daugardt) Foote of Belmont; a son, John A. Foote of Concord; a daughter, Anna M. Estes of Newfield, ME; four grandchildren, Christopher F. Estes and Eliza M. Estes both of Newfield, ME, and John A. Foote Jr. and Christina J. Foote both of Concord. He is also survived by several nieces and nephews, and was predeceased by his brother, Sheldon Foote of Weirs Beach.
