BELMONT — Henry Walter Gebo, 78, of 298 Depot St., Belmont, died Friday, Feb. 26, 1999, at Lakes Region General Hospital in Laconia following a period of failing health.

He was born in Fitchburg, Mass., Nov. 6, 1920, son of Julius and Ida (Carron) Gebo. Mr. Gebo had lived in Loudon and Tilton before becom-

ing a resident of Belmont 37 years ago.
