Belmont-----Carl E. Jewett, 80, of South Road, Belmont died at the Lakes Region General Hospital, Laconia on Sunday, October 31, 2004.

Mr. Jewett was born September 24, 1924 in Plainfield, CT, the son of Charles H. and Anna J (Edman) Jewett. He served in the U. S. Navy during WWII. Mr. Jewett lived in Belmont for most of his life and worked as a tool and die maker at N. H. Ballbearing and Scott & Williams.
