

Ralph L. Noyes, BELMONT - Worked as a mechanic for decades

BELMONT - Ralph L. Noyes, 77, of Laconia Road, died Saturday, Oct. 15, 2005, surrounded by his loving family at the Belknap County Nursing Home.
