Rose G. Turcotte

BELMONT — Mrs. Rose G. Turcotte, 98, of 31 Church Hill, died at Lakes Region General Hospital, Laconia, Tuesday evening, Feb. 9, 1999. She was the widow of Alcide G. Turcotte who died in 1969.
